Item 9	 Other Matters. Terry Westerway advised that a Lone Pine tree dedication will take place at Campbelltown VVAA in Queen St on 7 August 2015 attended by Turkish consular representatives commencing 11.00 AM Bert is persuing a 3D model of the ANKPQ/1 Radar unit for display in the 131 section of the National Vietnam Veterans Museum at Phillip Island Vic.
